



### **Rules of the competition “ Here is my Bay”**

- 1 - The theme of the competition is the presentation of today's bay and of tomorrow's.
- 2 - The competition is addressed to young students from 16 to 18 years old residing in the bay members of the most Beautiful Bays Club in the World-MBBWC-. The candidates can freely choose how they want to present the project: ie its length, duration...
- 3 -Written document illustrated by photos or drawings, a power point presentation or a movie are format examples for the presentation. The writing will be done in the language of origin and in one of the two following languages: English or French.
- 4 - The number of individual or collective projects is limited to five per bay. A first selection will be carried out by the school principals or the heads of the Youth club of each bay.
- 5 - All documents must be sent to the following website address: [concours@world-bays.com](mailto:concours@world-bays.com).
- 6 - The irremovable delay for the receipt of the documents is set for May 20th, 2008 at 1PM GMT.
- 7 - The jury will be composed of Boards' members as well as members from the organization committee of the competition. The verdict of the jury is to be without appeal or any kind of recourse. The jury will gather in May 2008.
- 8 - The results will be announced to the laureate June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2008 at the latest.
- 9 - The laureate will present his project during the Congress of the Most Beautiful Bays Club in the World, October, 3rd 2008. The winner will participate in a program organized by the local Youth Club.
- 10 - The expenses of the trip will be covered by the World Club and the expenses of the stay will be covered by the Canadian Bay, “Baie des Chaleurs.”
- 11 - The young laureate will be escorted by the representatives of his bay.
- 12 - The winning project will be circulated in its' entirety on the wiki bay of the club, as well as documents from other participants at the World Clubs discretion. The act of having passed on documents for the competition to the Club constitutes acceptance of the transfer of rights

from the author (s) to the World Club.

13 - Participation in this competition requires accepting the rules of this competition.

14 – The winners cannot in any circumstances claim the value of their prize in money.

16 - In case of act of God (force majeure), the organisers have the right to shorten, prolong, modify or cancel the competition.
